Let me know what you will be bringing.

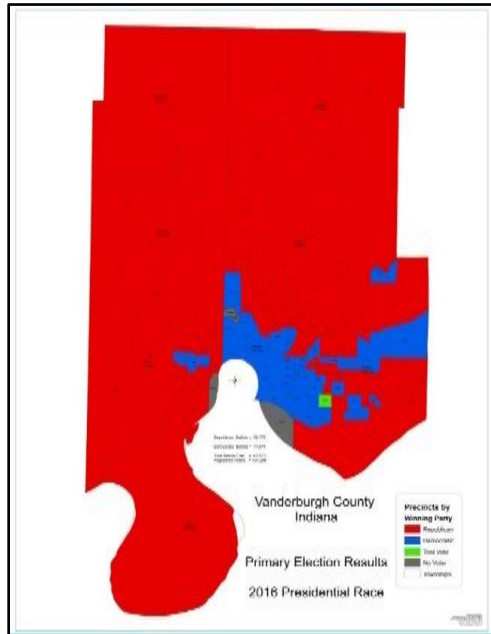
